“BUY A BRICK” FUNDRAISER

The goal of the Northampton Area Konkrete Kids Educational Foundation is to develop, promote, and finance innovative programs, which supplement and enhance the quality of education and provide the school community with extended learning opportunities and co-curricular experiences within the Northampton Area School District.

You may support the Foundation by having your name engraved on a brick paver that will be placed within the plaza outside the entrance of Al Erdosy Stadium and the new District swimming pool adjacent to the back High School parking lot. Included in this area will be a new bus loop and a new memorial plaza. This area will be the center of the secondary campus, and the brick paver area is scheduled to be open in September 2015.

Two brick paver sizes are available for purchase:

- 4” x 8” brick paver – 3 lines of engraving with 13 characters per line (letters, numbers, and spaces)
- 8” x 8” brick paver – 6 lines of engraving with 13 characters per line (letters, numbers, and spaces)

Only a person’s name, family name, in memory of, in honor of, and year of graduation, if applicable, from Northampton Area High School are allowed on the brick. You may also incorporate the District name “Konkrete Kids” or “Konkrete Kid” in the allotted spaces on your brick paver. Northampton Area School District past and present employees may incorporate their title (Example: John Doe, Teacher) on the brick paver. Titles/ranks of those who served in the military (Example: General Doe Class of 1975) will also be allowed. Nicknames, symbols, animal/pet names, and business names are prohibited.

The District will determine the color, size, and font of the brick paver and will have final approval of the inscription requested. All fonts will be centered, upright, and placed in the same direction. Once installed, the brick paver becomes the property of the District. All School District policies and procedures are in effect for this project, and final approval for a brick paver will be made by the District’s Facilities Committee which meets once per month.
